Few places compare to the beauty of the Pacific Northwest with the majesty of snow-capped Mount Rainer framing the back drop for Seattle to the east, and beautiful Puget Sound and the San Juan Islands to the west. There is outstanding scenery in all directions!

Day 1 – Tuesday, Sept 25

Our early morning, non-stop flight from Boston arrives in Seattle in time for lunch (on own) at the famous *Pike Place Market* on the waterfront. The market opened in 1907 and is one of the oldest continuously operated public farmers' markets in the US. Fishing boats off load at nearby piers so restaurants and stalls offer fresh fish from ocean to table making a great lunch easily found.

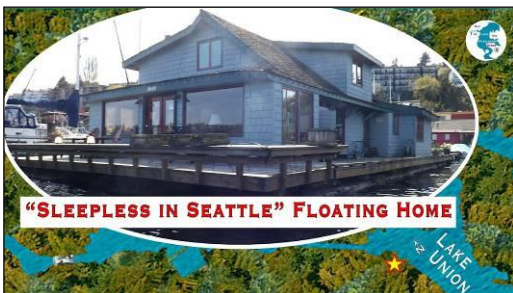
After lunch, our local guide will take us on a tour of downtown Seattle, the Waterfront, Pioneer Square, Chinatown, Seattle Center to see more outstanding views of the city. We'll also visit the Ballard Locks with ladders for the spawning salmon, the giant bridge Troll and the famous "*Sleepless in Seattle*" floating house.

A Welcome Dinner is planned for tonight at the Old Spaghetti Factory. **Welcome Dinner, 4 nights Seattle, Washington**

Day 2 – Wednesday, Sept 26

No visit to Seattle is complete without a visit to *Seattle's Best Starbucks Roastery and Tasting Room*. Here you'll learn about coffee from the arrival of the unroasted beans in the green coffee loading pit, through the roasting process, to pouring your cup of coffee!

After lunch, we'll venture underground for a guided "Beneath the Streets" tour where Seattle is "frozen in time". You'll learn the history of the birth of the city, stories including the Klondike Gold Rush, Skid Row, 1890's architecture and learn the ways of the Coast Salish Peoples who first inhabited the area. **B, D**



Day 3 – Thursday, Sept 27

An exciting day is planned on Puget Sound to see killer whales, porpoises, dolphins, seals, sea lions, otters and seabirds during our Whale Watch Cruise aboard the *Chilkat Express*. Cruising at 40mph, the catamaran is the fastest whale watching boat in the northwest. The boat features indoor seating with large windows and outside viewing decks plus a great galley for lunch (on own).

This afternoon, we switch gears from the sea to the air with a guided tour of the Boeing Company Factory facility where Boeing's 737 Next Generation and MAX airliners are built. The floor space of this giant facility covers 1.1 million square feet!

We'll head back to the city for a visit to Seattle's famous Space Needle and Observation Deck for a 360 degree panoramic views of the city framed by the beautiful surrounding mountains to the east and San Juan Islands to the west.

Seattle is home to celebrated artist, Dale Chihuly and we'll visit Chihuly Glass Museum and Gardens located next to the Needle. As we walk through exhibits that feature some of the famous glass blower's most spectacular pieces, you'll want to have your cameras ready to capture the beauty of the large colorful displays. Included is a film narrated by the artist himself demonstrating how he creates his beautiful works of art that are exhibited around the world. **B, D**



Day 4 – Friday, Sept 28

This morning we are transferred to the ferry terminal for our cruise aboard the *Victoria Clipper* from downtown Seattle across Puget Sound to Victoria, BC, Canada (**Valid Passport REQUIRED**). After a guided city tour to learn the history and see the landmarks, we'll visit world-famous Butchart Gardens with time to explore the gardens' 55 acres of floral splendor.

Dinner is planned at a popular restaurant when we return to the mainland. **B, D**

Day 5 – Saturday, Sept 29

This morning we check out of our Seattle hotel and make our way to Oregon for a visit to Mt St Helens. The 96 mile drive will take us through the beautiful Cascade Mountain Range to the Mt St Helens Visitor Center in the heart of the blast zone. There we will learn the story surrounding the horrific volcanic eruption that took place in 1980 that was the deadliest and most economically destructive volcanic event in the history of the United States. Fifty-seven people were killed, 250 homes, 47 bridges, 15 miles of railways, and 185 miles of highway were all destroyed. You'll have a close-up view of the mountain and cavern left behind by the side-blow blast.

We'll overnight in Portland, Oregon's largest city, with its dramatic location on the Columbia and Willamette Rivers in the shadow of snow-capped Mount Hood. Dinner tonight will be in one of the city's popular restaurants. **B, D, Overnight Portland, Oregon**



Day 6 – Sunday, Sept 30

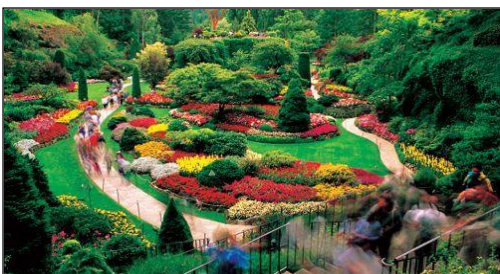
A fun day is planned beginning with a tour of the city with a local guide to show us all the highlights of Portland known for its beautiful parks, bridges, and Japanese Garden.

Before making our way back to Seattle, we'll drive along the shore of the beautiful Columbia River to the Gorge and see stunning waterfalls stopping for photos along the way. Along our route we'll visit a dam and fish ladder where salmon fight their way up the powerful river every year to spawn. **B, Overnight Seattle**
