Day 1 – Monday, June 3

We’ll begin our visit with a guided tour of Grand Central Station, serving New Yorkers since its completion in 1903 and now the city’s newest attraction. You’ll learn the history and walk in the overwhelming splendor of Grand Central’s vast, majestic spaces. The architects brought in Parisian artists to craft bronze and stone carvings, including ornamental inscriptions, and sculpted oak leaves and acorns (symbols of the Vanderbilt family.) Over 10,000 people a day walk through her doors not to catch a train, but, to have lunch in one of her many restaurants, food courts and market.



After a busy day, you’ll be ready for a relaxing dinner buffet at our hotel just across the river in Secaucus, NJ for easy access into the city. **D Buffet, 3-Nights Hilton Garden Inn, Secaucus, NJ**

Day 2 – Tuesday, June 4

Today you will experience a different “slice” of NYC life that most have never seen before! We’ll join a fun 4-hour driving tour to explore Brooklyn with our Local Guide, who with his “Fuhgettaboutits”, sounds as if he just escaped from the TV show “The Sopranos”. “A Slice of Brooklyn Pizza Tour” has been featured on The Today Show, Food Network, and the Travel Channel with rave reviews.



Before becoming one of NYC’s 5 Boroughs in 1898, Brooklyn was the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest city in the country. There is much to learn during our visit AND much to eat with the Progressive Pizza Lunch that stops at many famous Brooklyn restaurants such as Grimaldi’s for Neapolitan-style pizza and L&B Spumoni Gardens for Sicilian-style pizza and more! We’ll make a stop on the waterfront for the best photos of the Brooklyn Bridge, visit famous Brooklyn movie locations, and learn about the large Hasidic Jewish population that lives and works in the borough.

### Day 3 – Wednesday, June 5

We'll start our day with a visit to the Tenement Museum on the Lower East Side for a guided tour that showcases "Irish Outsiders", their joys and struggles as immigrants attempting to assimilate in their adopted country.

This afternoon is planned on Broadway for a performance of the Hit Musical "Come From Away". This New York Times Critics Pick takes you into the heart of the remarkable true story of 7,000 stranded airline passengers and the small Newfoundland town that welcomed them into their homes on 9/11. This heartwarming story takes you to a place you never want to leave as we follow their journey from stunned shock to the start of lifelong friendships.

The remainder of the day will be on your own in Times Square for dinner and to enjoy the illuminated night scene as the square is transformed into a sea of glittering lights. **Note: Our bus back to our NJ hotel departs 9:00. B**

### Day 4 – Thursday, June 5

Before making our way home, we'll join a guided tour of the 9/11 Memorial Museum that commemorates one of the most tragic events in our nation's history. No one will ever forget where they were on the morning of Tuesday, September 11, 2001, a day etched in minds forever. **B**
