Cruise over 30 miles passing by TEN scenic and historic lighthouses that strategically dot the shores of Rhode Island's Narragansett Bay during a 90-minute narrated cruise. These nostalgic structures have warned mariners of danger along the coast and islands for over two centuries. The highlight of the day will be cruising into lovely Newport Harbor surrounded by yachts visiting from around the world, cruise ships, and, if the wind is up, you may be treated to the famous 12 meter America's Cup boats under full sail.

We'll board the Coast Guard Certified, 400 passenger catamaran, *Millennium*, at Quonset Point for a memorable afternoon with an expert guide who will inform and entertain us with local maritime folklore. Cameras are required gear for this exciting afternoon.

Included in this day's adventure is a guided tour of the Rhode Island State Capitol Building in Providence. It was designed by the architectural firm of McKim, Mead, and White and constructed of Georgian marble from 1895 to 1904. Its dome is the fourth-largest in the world after St. Peters, the Taj Mahal, and the Minnesota State Capitol Building.
